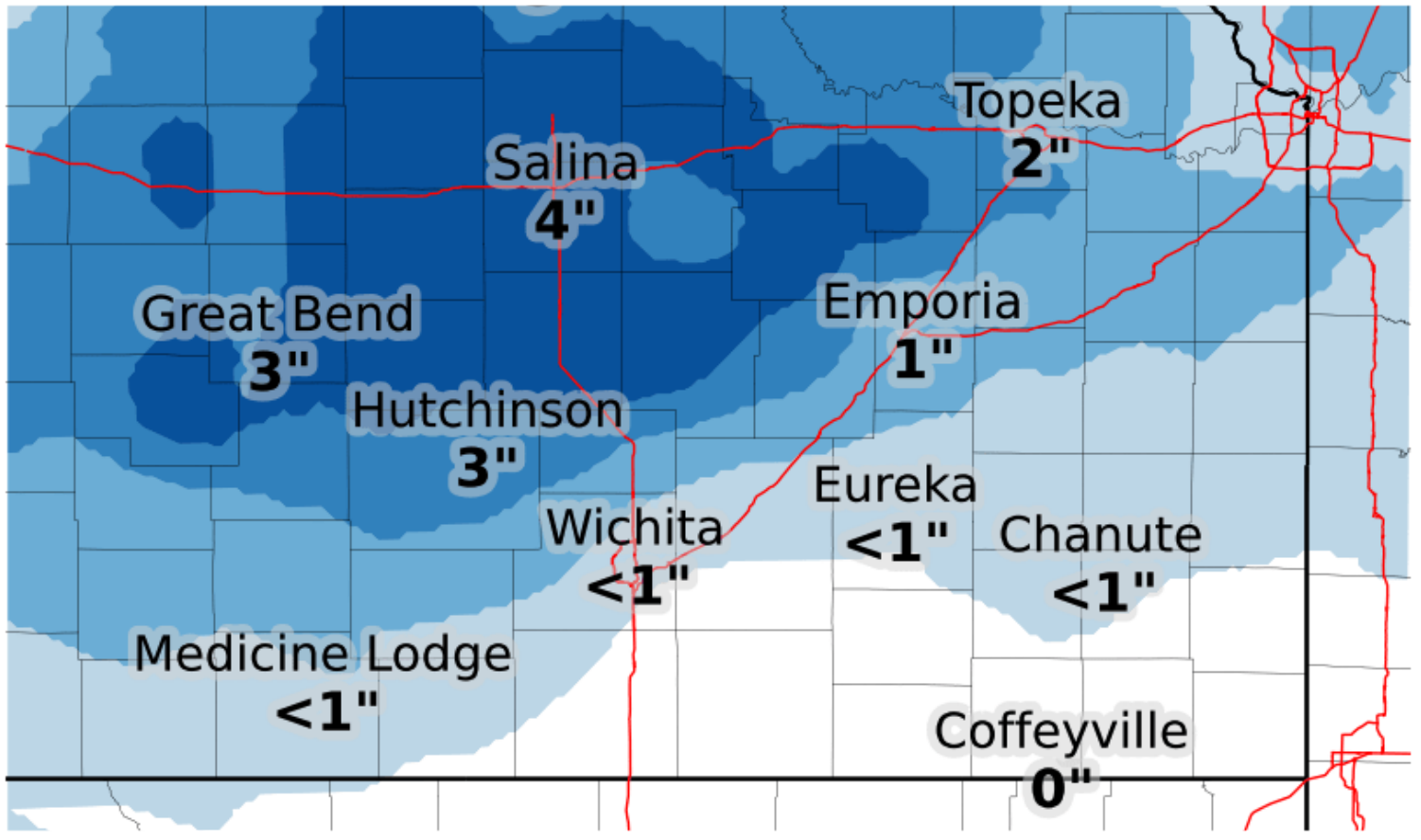




Potential Snowfall Today



Weather Message of the Day:



Rain will mix with and change over to snow today. Most of the snow will end by the evening. Highest amounts are expected along US-50 with lesser amounts to the south. Periods of sleet are also possible today.

Important Forecast Changes:



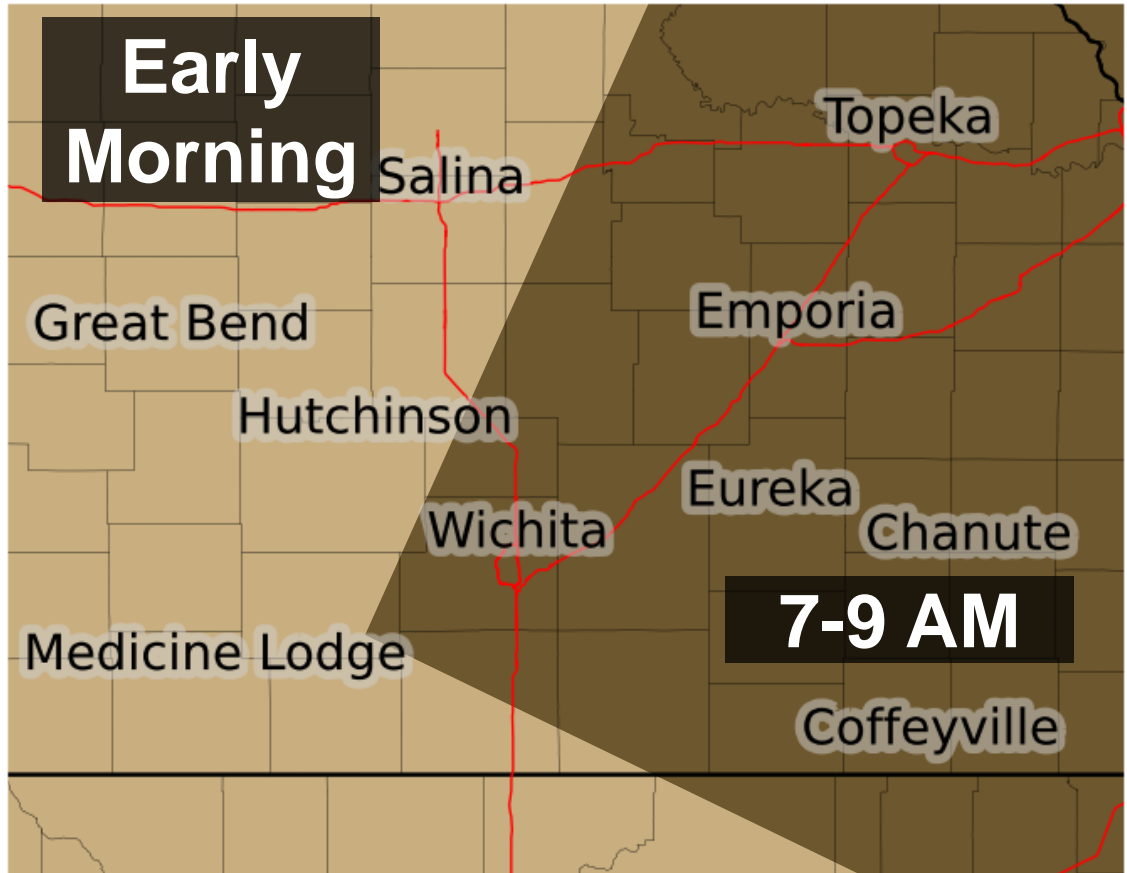

Change(s) since last report: Changes to the location of the heaviest expected snowfall.

Location

Timing: Many areas of the region have already started with rain /sleet /snow.

Magnitude: The magnitude of this event will be highly depended on the location but expect the higher amounts to be in the 3-6 inch range with an average of 2-4 inches.

Location: Highest amounts are expected along US-50 but a slight deviation of as little as 20 miles will have a significant impact on where the higher amounts fall. Confidence is lower on location.



Weather Message of the Day

Rain will mix with and change to snow today. Generally 2-4 inches of snow can be expected, with locally higher amounts possible, especially along US-50.

IMPACTS:

- Untreated roads will become slick. Possibility of school closings and delays.
- Slick roads, bridges, parking lots and sidewalks. School closings and delays area likely. Possible adjustments to government operations. Some flight delays are possible.
