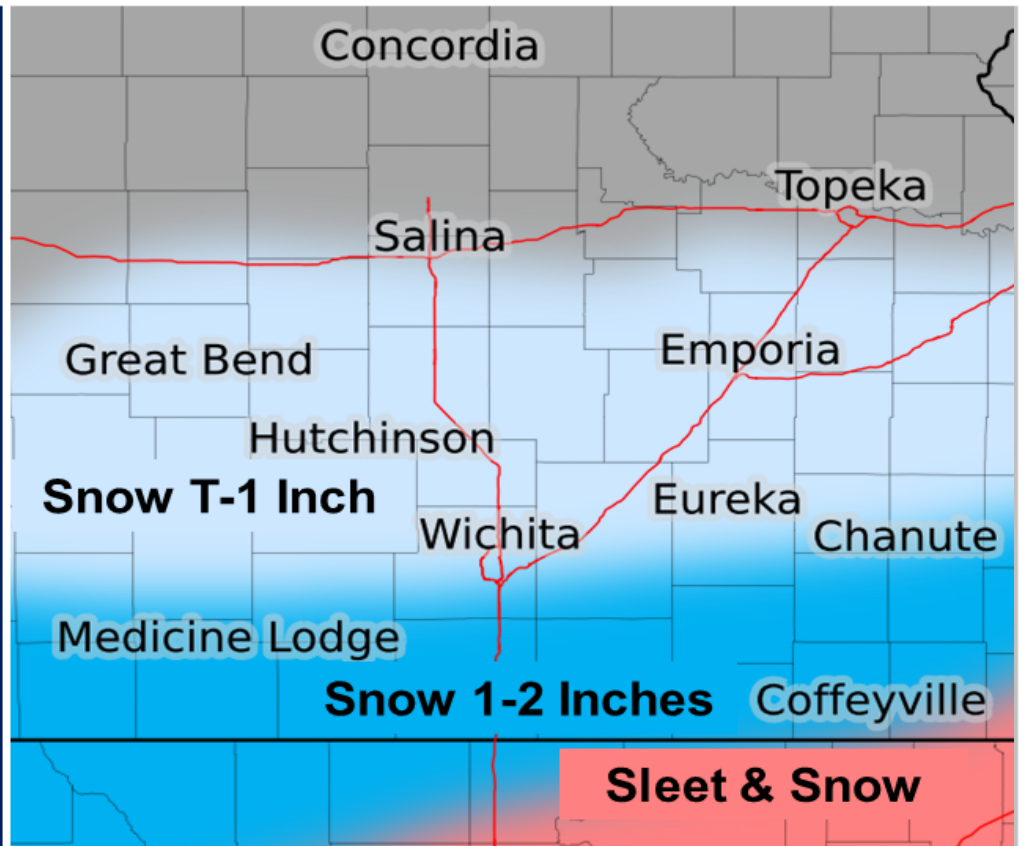




## Friday Night and Saturday

**Highest snow amounts expected along the OK and KS state line**

### Weather Message of the Day:



Snow will begin Friday night and into Saturday. Most areas will only see a Trace to an inch but up to 2 inches will be possible along the OK/KS state line. Extreme Southeast KS could see a brief period of freezing rain, sleet and snow.

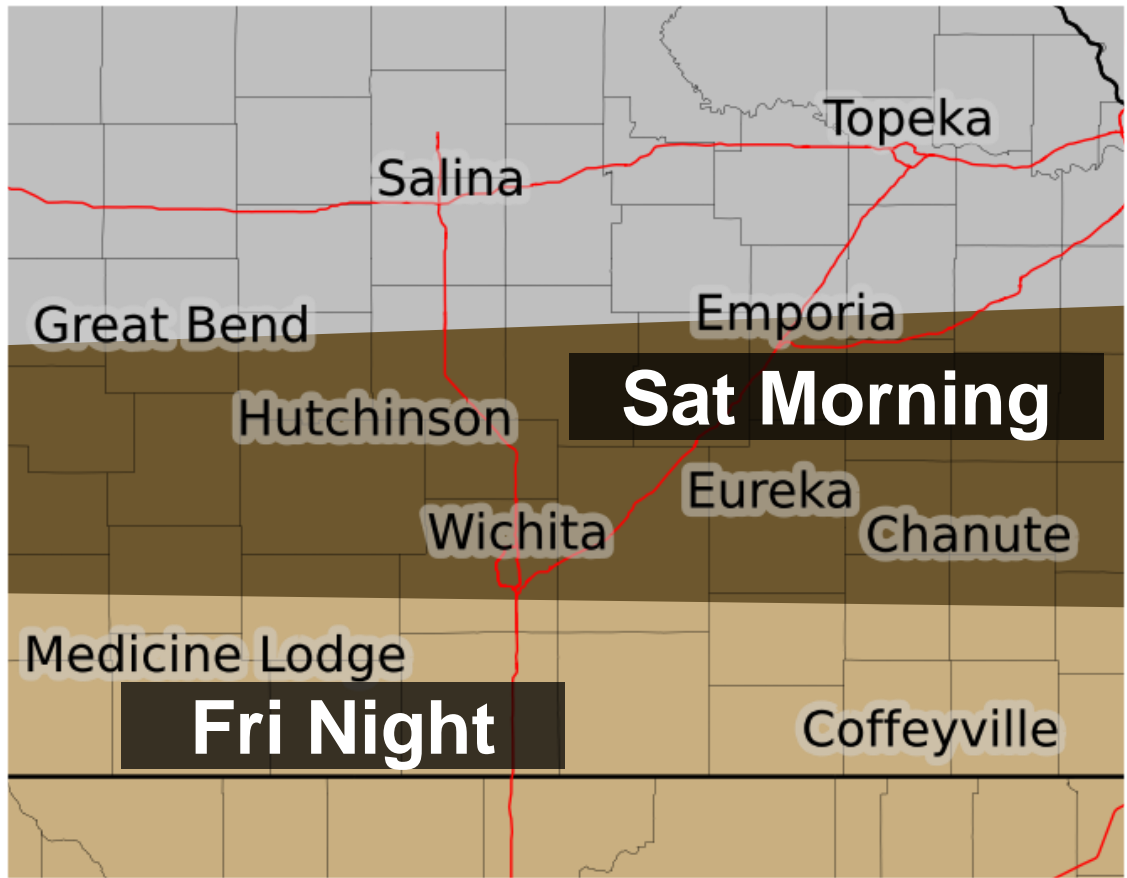


**Timing:** Winter precipitation is expected to start along the OK/KS state line Friday night and spread north.

**Magnitude:** Confidence is good with the magnitude of this event. Heaviest snowfall is expected along the KS/OK state line with lighter amounts further north

**Location:** Confidence is good in regard to the location of the heaviest snowfall amounts.



## Weather Message of the Day

A brief period of mixed wintery precipitation in far Southeast Kansas Friday night with all areas having primarily snow for Saturday. Highest snowfall amounts are expected along the KS/OK state line.

### IMPACTS:

- Slick roads, bridges, parking lots and sidewalks. Possible adjustments to government operations. Some flight delays are possible.
