



What

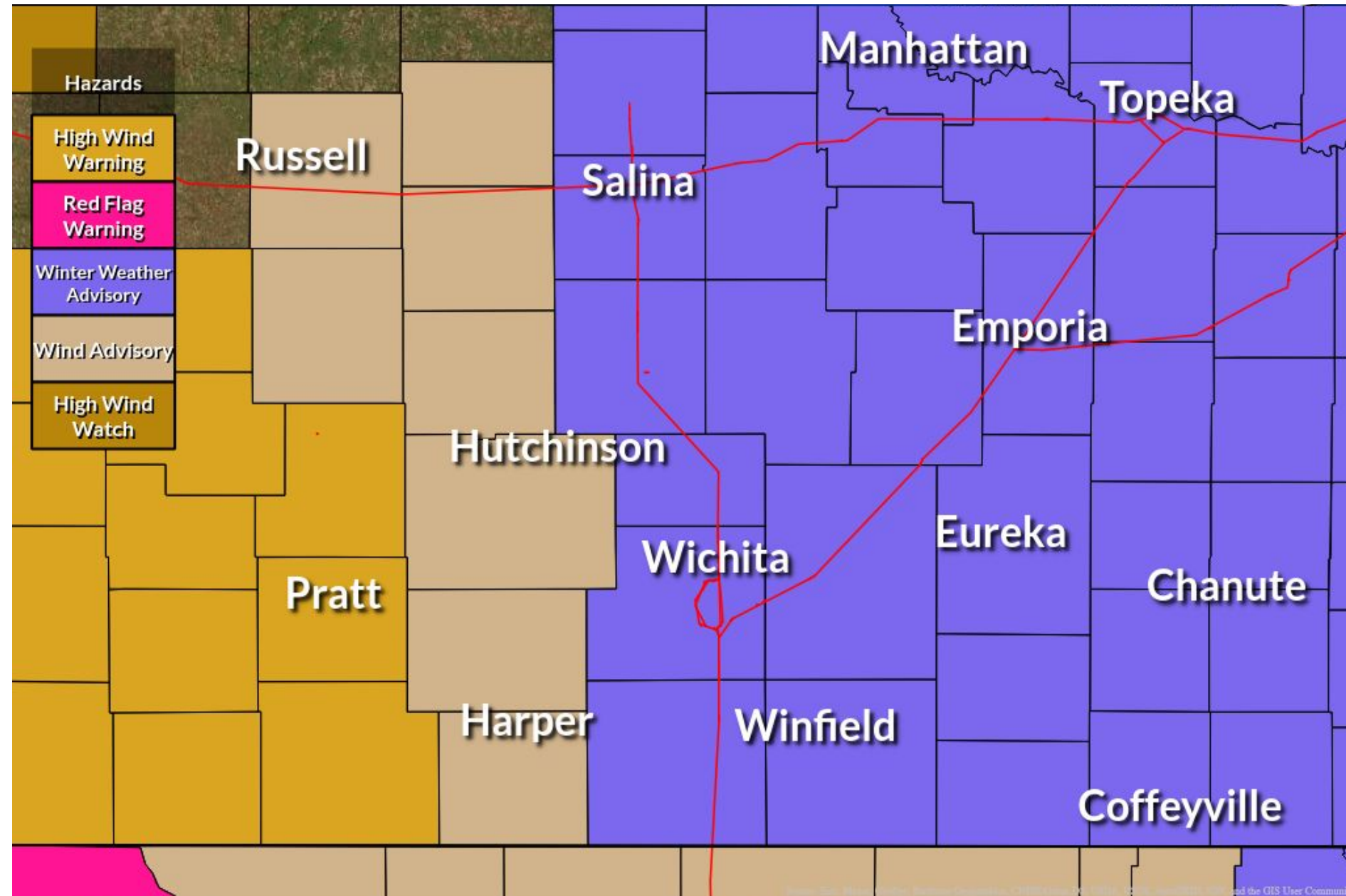
- Periods of moderate to heavy snow with strong gusty winds. Blowing snow will lead to reduced visibilities and hazardous travel.

- First round of snow will occur late this evening with the second round of snow starting early Saturday morning.



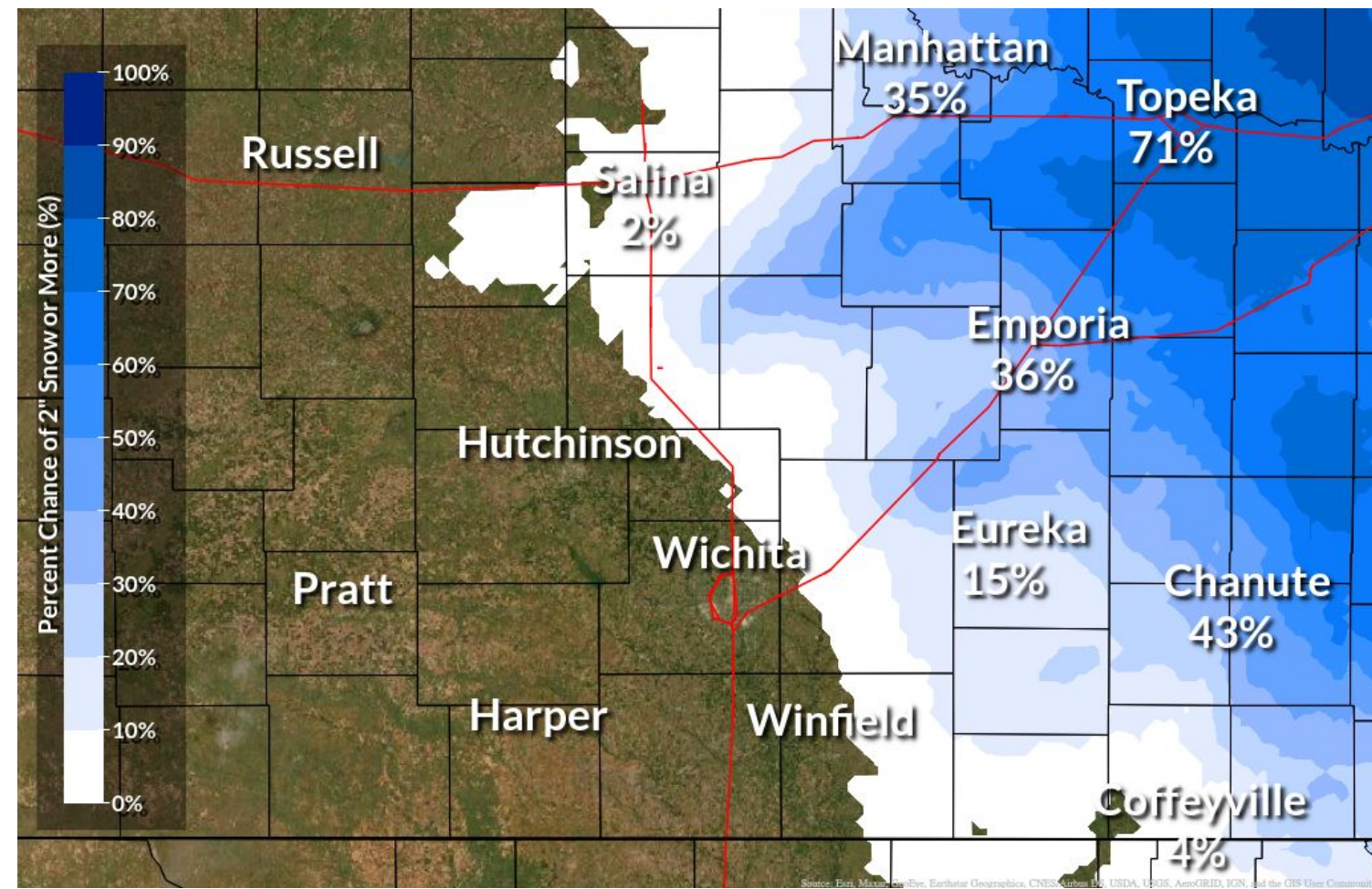
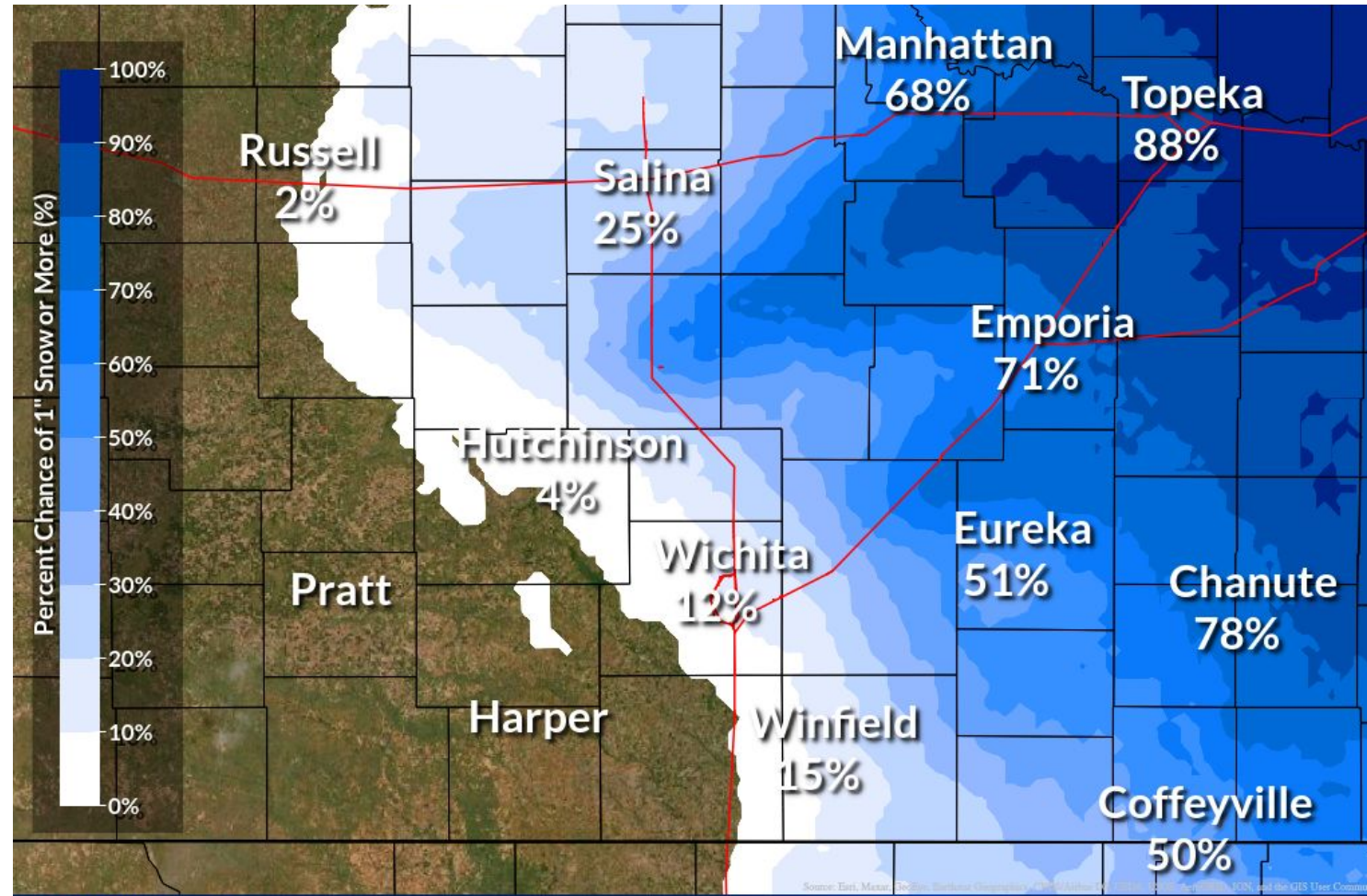


Snow probabilities

While confidence is high that the higher amounts with this system will be east of I-135, confidence is much lower on what the upper end of the amounts will be. Current thinking right now is that there is potential amounts could be increased over eastern KS with later forecasts

Location

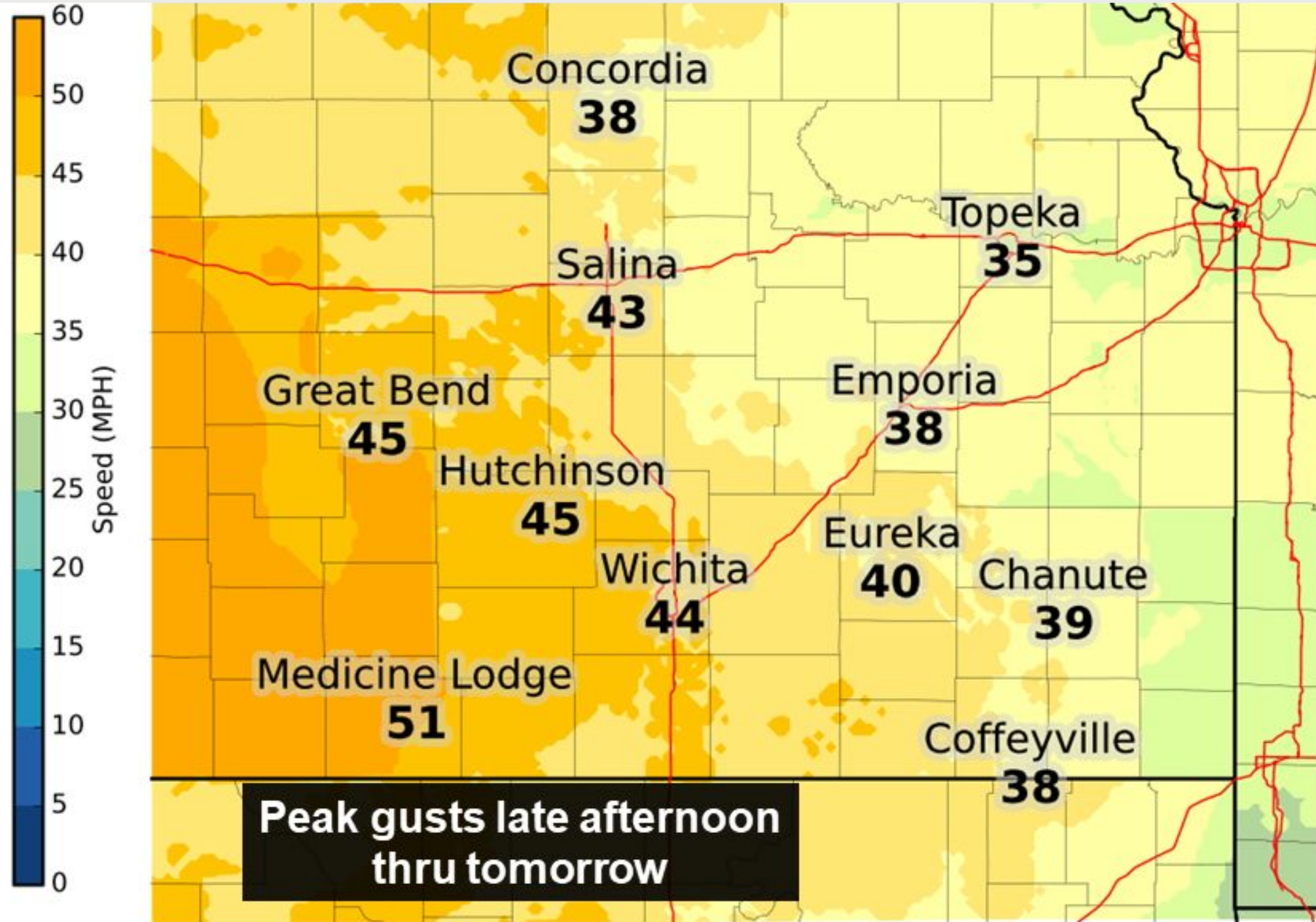


While confidence is high that the higher amounts will be east of I-135, how far west the 1-2 inch range is still uncertain.
